

## Tools Required




#### **Prior to Installation**

- Observe all local plumbing and building codes before you begin installation.
- Carefully shut off both hot and cold main water supplies.
- Select pipe nipples long enough to extend through the finished wall.
- Pioneer reserves the right to make changes in the design of faucets without notice as specified in the pricebook.
- Carefully inspect drain and supply lines for any sign of damage.


#### Faucet Installation

- Remove the old faucet if this installation is for replacement.
- Confirm the distance between inlet pipes from 3-1/2" (8.89 cm) to 8-1/2" (21.59 cm.) maximum apart. Apply the Teflon Tape or sealant at the end of inlet pipes if necessary.
- Hand tighten eccentric elbow (A) onto each 1/2" diameter inlet pipes.
- Thread the faucet (C) assembly onto the eccentric elbows (A). Note: Do not forget to place the washers (B) between the eccentric elbows (A) and the faucet (C).
- Confirm the eccentric elbows (B) are aligned and level with each other.
  Further tighten the elbows if necessary. Do not overtighten. Caution:
  Please be careful and do not damage the finish on the eccentric elbows (A) when installing.
- Verify the faucet (C) is properly aligned and level. If necessary make adjustments by repositioning the eccentric elbows (A).



#### **Faucet Installation**

- Ensure the eccentric elbow (A) is flushed with the finished wall (D).
- Remove aerator (E).
- Turn on water. Check for any leaks. Make sure all the connections are secure.
- · Open the both side of handles.
- Allow water to run at full flow for at least one minute.
- Replace aerator (E).
